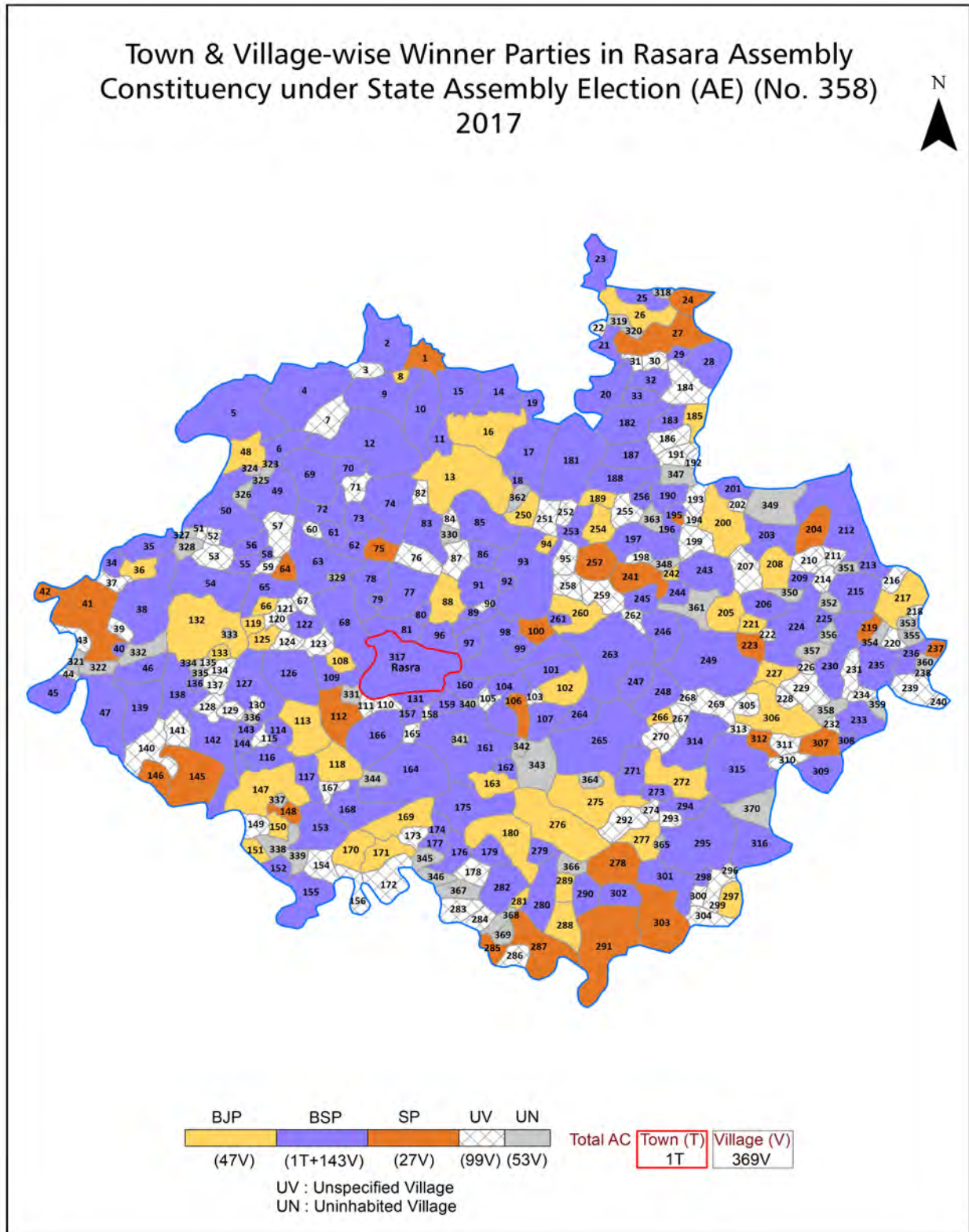

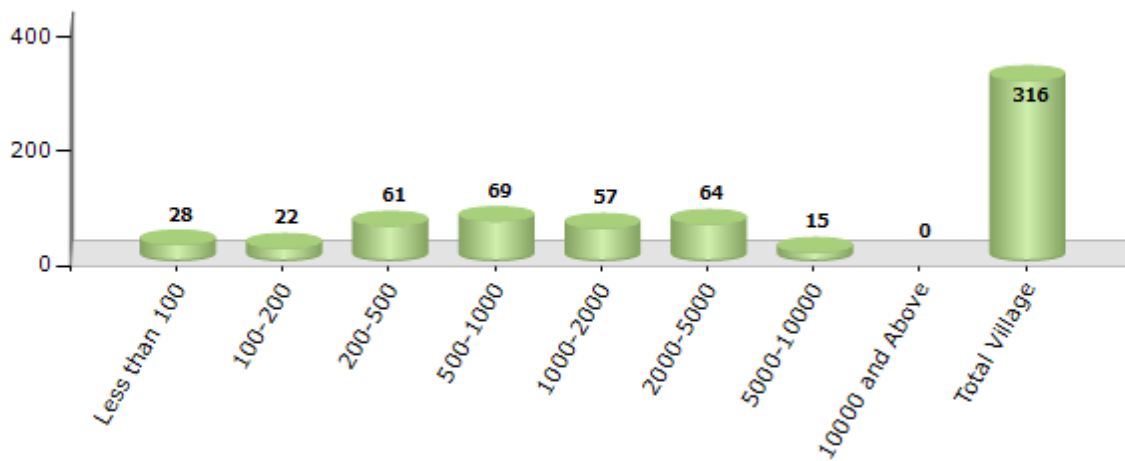

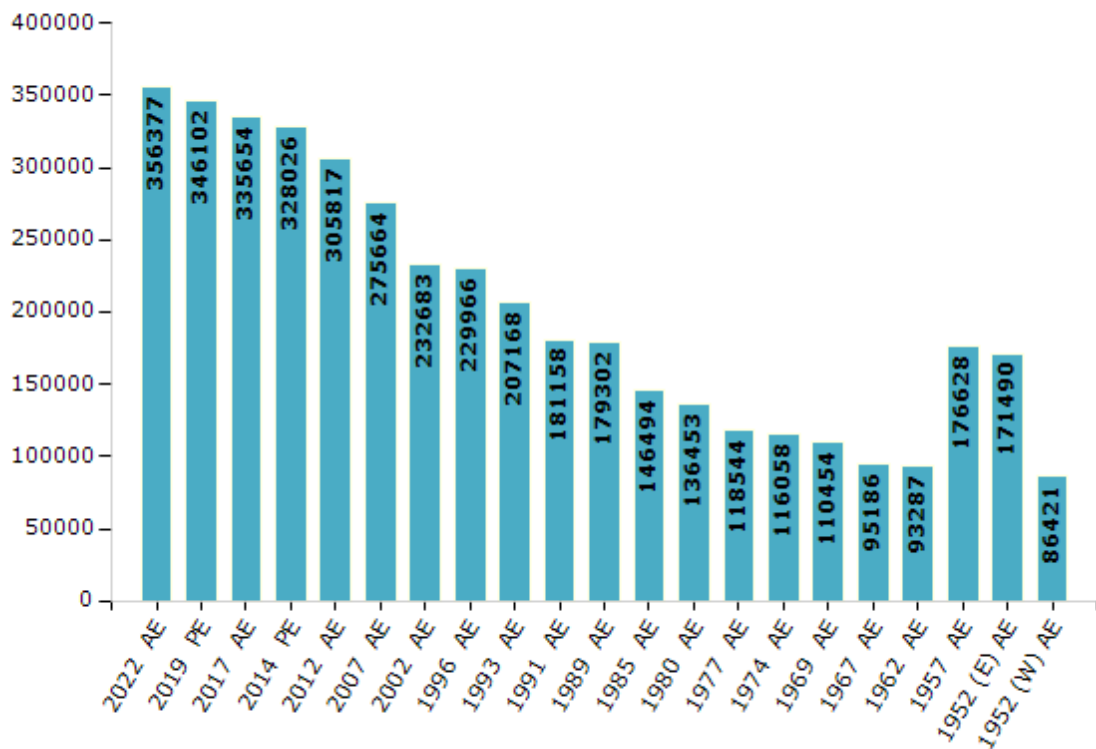

Number of Electors



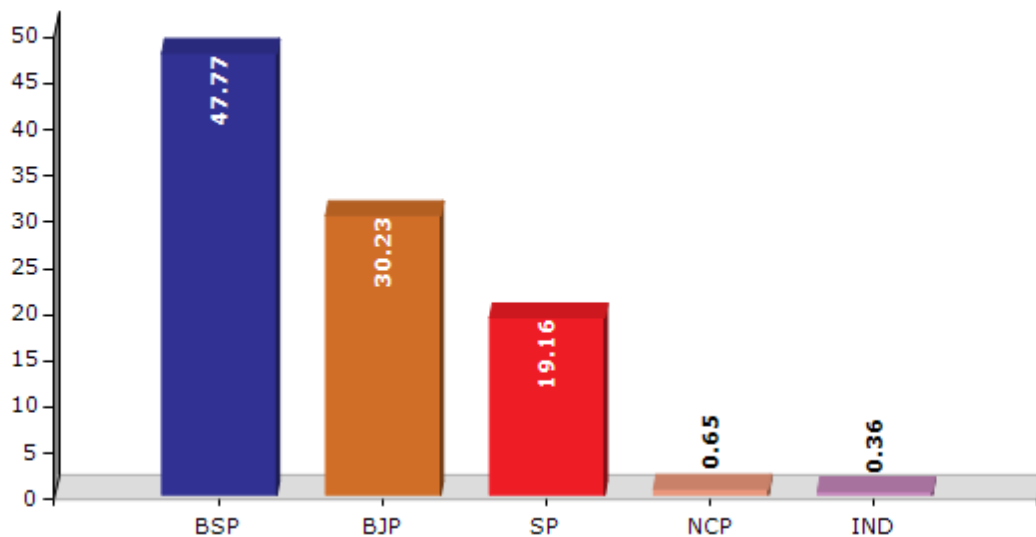
